City College of San Francisco is committed to offering a safe and healthy environment for students and employees. Communicable diseases are an ongoing concern.

In order to control communicable diseases within the college community, and manage diseases such as the COVID-19 pandemic, CCSF adheres to guidelines and public health advisories issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH). The intent of this Policy is to maintain good standards of communicable disease control that protect the health and safety of the college community, while not unduly restricting the educational pursuits of individuals with communicable diseases.

The Chancellor shall establish procedures necessary to protect students and employees and assure cooperation with local and public health officials for the prevention and control of communicable diseases throughout the college community.
