BOARD POLICY MANUAL**

<b>Title:</b> <b>STUDENT DISCIPLINE</b>	<b>Number:</b> <b>BP 5.17</b>
<b>Legal Authority:</b> <b>California Education Code Sections Education Code Sections 66300, 66301, 72212, 76030, 76031, 76032, 76033, 76034, 76035, 76036, 76037, and 78907</b>	

Disciplinary sanctions for violations of the Code of Student Conduct shall include but are not limited to warning; verbal and/or written reprimand; a failing grade on an assignment or test or in a class in proven cases of cheating, plagiarism or other forms of academic dishonesty; disciplinary probation; ineligibility to participate in extra-curricular activities; removal from class by the instructor for no more than two class meetings; removal from an instructional laboratory, facility, center or other supervised student activity by the designated site administrator for no more than two sessions, meetings or days; suspension from classes by the Chancellor (or designee) for up to the remainder of the school term or from all classes and activities of the District for one or more terms; expulsion.

The Chancellor shall present all recommendations for expulsion to the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall consider an expulsion recommendation in closed session unless the student requests that the matter be considered in a public meeting. Final action by the Board of Trustees on the expulsion shall be taken at a public meeting. This policy and the associated administrative procedures shall be made widely available to students through the College Catalog and other means.

The Chancellor shall adopt administrative procedures to provide for the denial of admission to a student who has been expelled from another community college within five years and who poses a continuing physical danger.
