Dr. Natalie Berg

Natalie Berg, Ed.D., was Vice President of the Board of Trustees in 2009. She was Board VP 2008. She served as Board President in 2006, 2001 and 1997. Dr. Berg was elected to the San Francisco Community College District Board of Trustees in November 1996 and re-elected in 2000, 2004 and 2008. She chairs the Board's Community Relations Committee and is a member of the Policy Implementation Committee.

Prior to her service on the Board, Dr. Berg had served City College of San Francisco in a number of faculty and administrative capacities spanning 30 years. She retired

as Dean of the John Adams Campus and the School of Health and Physical Education, a post to which she was appointed in 1991.

She was Senior Vice President of Forest City Development, a major national development company. Active in the community, Dr. Berg was honored in 2005, 2006, 2007 and again in 2008 by *The San Francisco Business Times* as one of "The 100 Most Influential Women in the San Francisco Bay Area." Additionally, the *San Francisco Business Times* chose Dr. Berg to be on the "Forever Honor Roll" of the most influential women.

From 1967 through 1976, Dr. Berg was an instructor in English, English as a Second Language, History and Civics. In 1976 she was appointed administrative assistant to the President of the Community College Centers Division, and in 1977 to administrative assistant to the Vice Chancellor, Personnel. In 1980 she was named Coordinator, Personnel Relations, and in 1984 became the Director, Employee Relations.

Dr. Berg earned her Ed.D. degree in Community College Administration/Curriculum from Nova University, Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Her MA degree is in Educational Administration/College Finance from San Francisco State University. She holds a BA in Economics from UC Berkeley.

Dr. Berg's professional affiliations include the American Association of Women in Community and Junior Colleges; Lambda Alpha International, an honorary land use association; Member, California Community Colleges Board of Governors; Past President, Jewish Community Relations Council; Board President, Jewish Vocational Services Board; Board member, Yerba Buena Community Benefits District; and President, The Market Street Association.

She is married to Peter M. Finnegan, a former member and president of the City College Board of Trustees.
