Course Descriptions

IDST 80C – Diversity and Social Justice: Sexism

Explore the personal, cultural and institutional dimensions of sexism and develop strategies to address this and other forms of oppression in your daily life. This course features participatory learning, videos, and a lot of dialogue. Break down the barriers that keep us apart and empower yourself with knowledge to create social change.

IDST 80D – Diversity and Social Justice: Heterosexism

This course is a consciousness raising analysis and evaluation of homophobia/heterosexism on individual, interpersonal, institutional and cultural levels in the United States. The primary goals of this short course are to expand one's knowledge about heterosexism and related forms of oppression (homophobia, biphobia, transphobia), increase personal awareness of one's own heterosexism and assumptions, and to apply this knowledge and awareness towards individual and social change.
