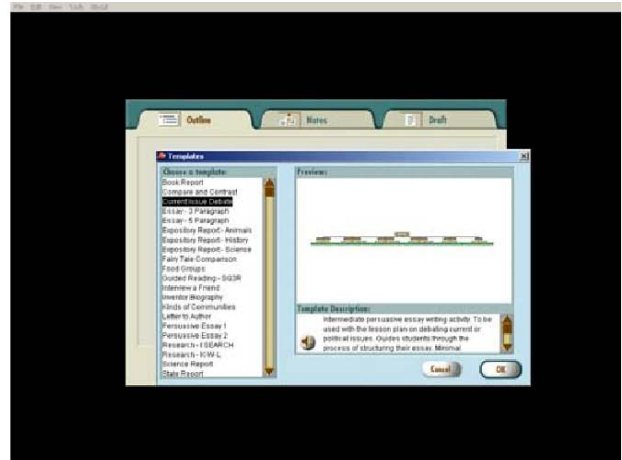


Build an essay with Draft:Builder. Outline your ideas, take notes, & draft your essay.

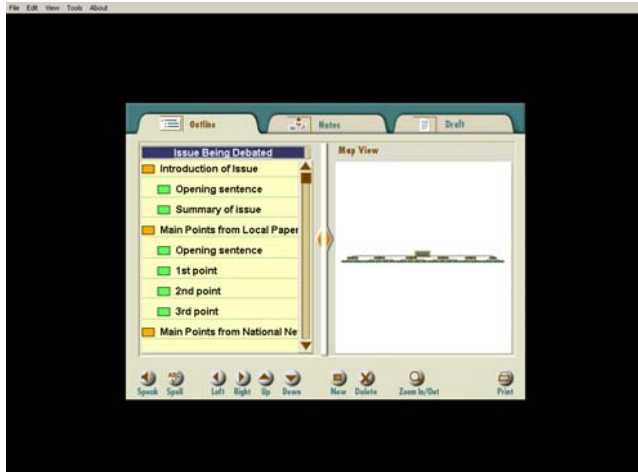
1—What would you like to do? How about opening a template?



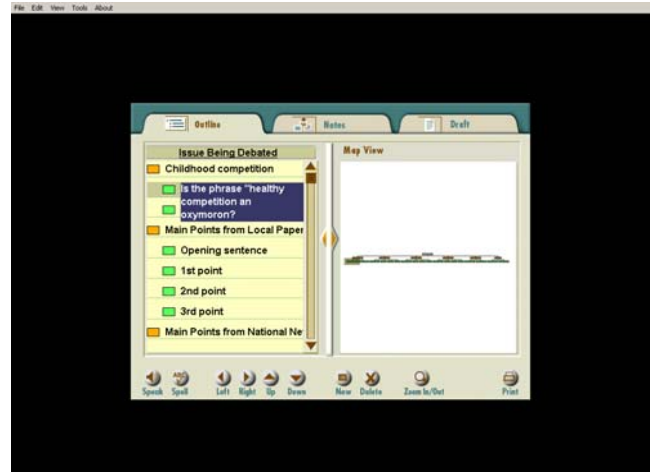
2—Choose the template that best fits your assignment.



3—Click on a general item in the outline to the left and replace it with your specific ideas.



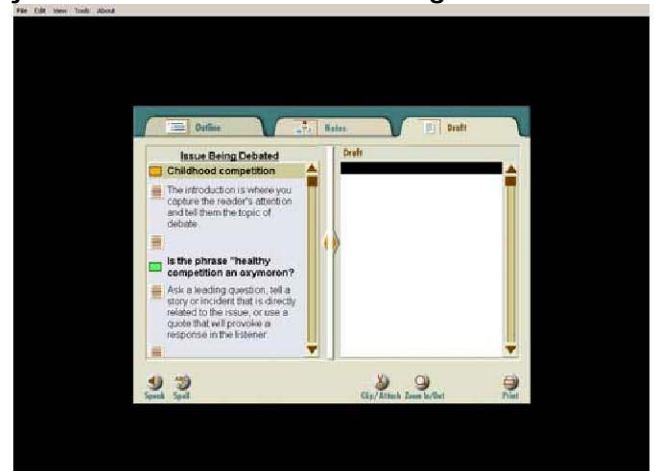
4—The preview will show you an updated essay map.

6—Let your outline & notes guide you in building your draft in the window to the right.



To take your work with you, copy and paste your text into Microsoft Word and save the new document to your disk. If you save it as a Draft:Builder document, you will need the Draft:Builder program on your computer to open and continue working on it. You can also save it as a text file.
