- **available to work between 5 and 15 hours each week**
- **enrolled in at least 5 units at City College**

In order to apply for an interview, you must:

- **meet the requirements above and pick up an application packet from the Writing Lab**
- **obtain a recommendation from your English instructor (1A or above)**
- **provide a sample essay from English 1A or above, preferably thesis-based and/or argumentative**
