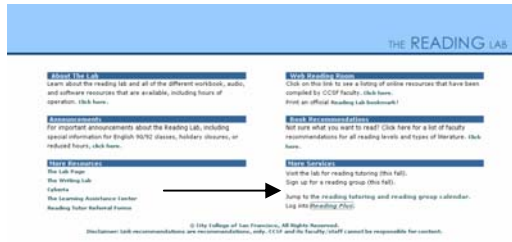


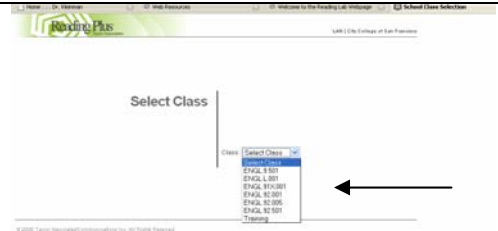
Reading Plus: How to Log On (campus connection only)

Find the Reading Plus link at the Reading Lab homepage or the Lab Page's Web Resources page.



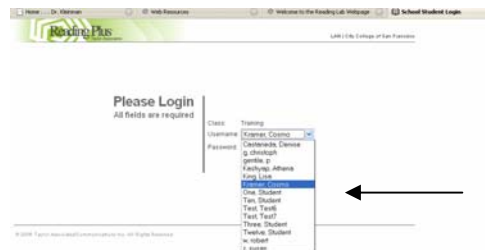

If you are asked for a SITE CODE, type "city." Then hit the "Student Login" button and select your class and section.



Remember your class and section number. It will appear in the drop-down list only if your teacher is using Reading Plus; not everyone uses this program.

Once your classlist appears, select your name. Then follow the prompt to enter your password.



Your teacher will give you a simple password that may be customized at a later time.

When using Reading Plus for the first time, you will have to take the 3-part placement. Take this seriously so that you will be assigned the proper level.



Do not stop in the middle of one of the three placement stages or else the program will not remember your score. Once your placement has been completed and you are using PAVE, Guided Reading, or Reading Around Words, you may take a break at any time and the program will remember where you stopped. Since you will be using a campus computer, it is especially important that you use the "Quit" and "Log Out" buttons.
