SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION--2011

Every year between \$10,000 -\$15,000 in scholarships are awarded to students in Environmental Horticulture and Floristry. Scholarships are awarded by professional organizations such as the California Landscape Contractor's Association, garden clubs, individual sponsors and the department. Students are encouraged to apply for as many of these scholarships as they think they might qualify. Horticulture and Floristry students are also encouraged to apply for non-departmental scholarships through the campus scholarship office in 366 Batmale Hall (239-3339).

Several scholarships offered through the department require separate applications provided by the sponsors of the scholarships. Previous recipients of a scholarship will not be considered for an award from the same donor.

Applications must be submitted to a Department faculty member by 5 P.M., Friday April 29th. Electronic applications will not be accepted. Only paper applications will be accepted.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED or WORD-PROCESSED. If you would like an MS Word version of this application e-mailed to you, contact Mr. Hillan at jmhillan@ccsf.edu or check the department web site.

Criteria for scholarship awards will be based on the following:

1. Restrictions placed on the scholarship by the donor.
2. Evidence that the student meets the expectations of the donor or organization that established the award.
3. Evidence of scholastic performance and participation in departmental activities.
4. Evidence of commitment to the field of environmental horticulture or floristry, and continuing education or employment in those fields.

All scholarships will be accompanied by a certificate naming the student as a recipient of that particular award. **Recipients are expected to attend the awards ceremony planned for May 12, 4:00 p.m.**
