



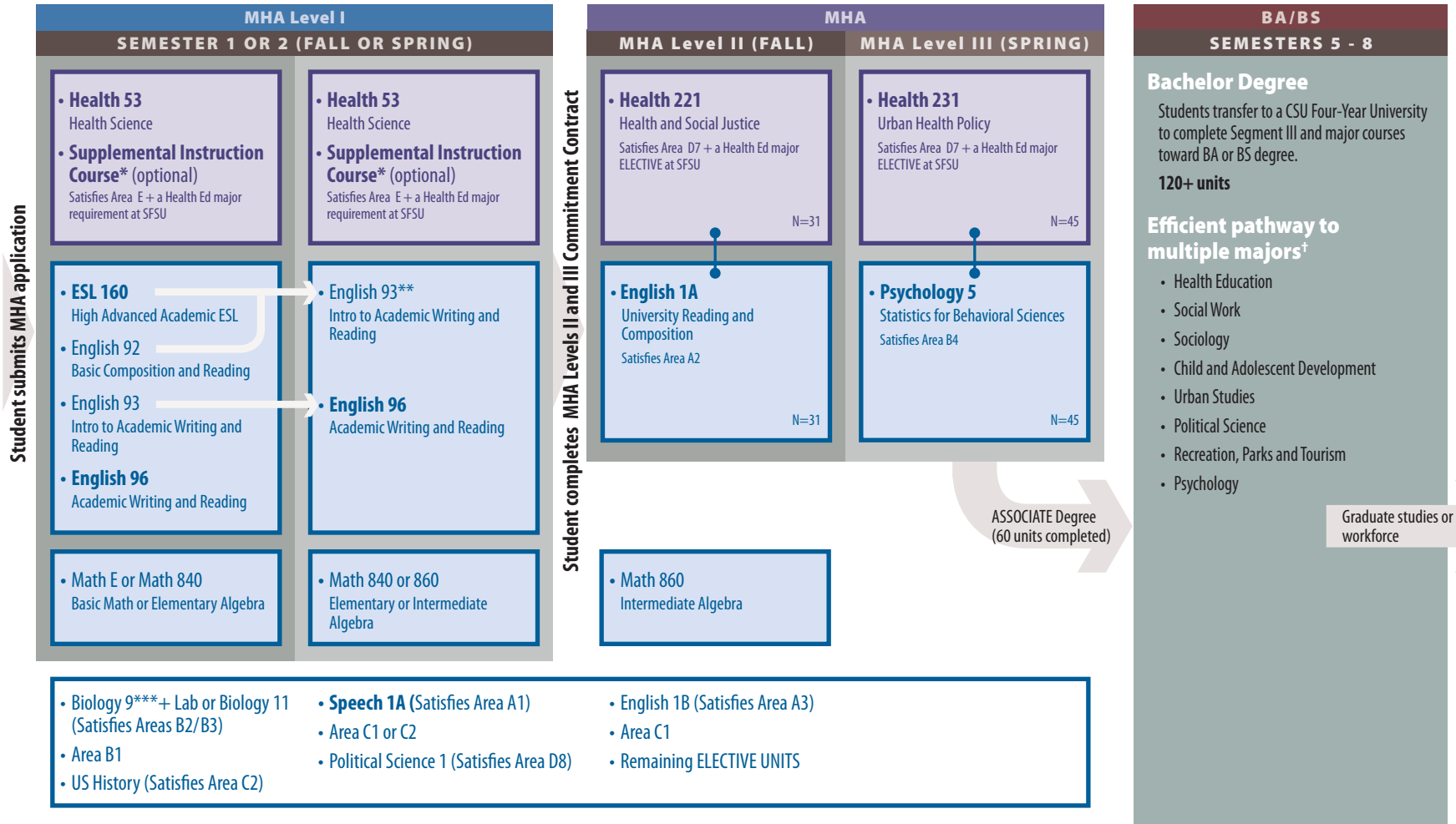
# Metropolitan Health Academy Course Sequence
