### **Important Change in Nursing Department requirements for Admission starting Application date January 20 – February 20, 2009**

The City College of San Francisco Nursing Department will institute the following new requirement for all applicants starting the application period of January 20 – February 20, 2009:

**All qualified applicants selected by lottery for enrollment for Fall 2009 and future semesters will be required to take the ATI “Test for Essential Academic Skills” (TEAS). The applicant must receive an overall score of 67% passing in order to be eligible to enroll in the program.**

Those applicants who do not receive an overall score of 67% on the TEAS must attend the remediation courses offered in the “Summer Bridge to Nursing” at City College of San Francisco in the same calendar year as their lottery and receive passing grades in each of the 3 courses (College Success Basics, Medical Terminology, and Medical Math).

If an applicant does not receive an overall score of 67% on the TEAS and does not enroll and successfully complete the courses in the Summer Bridge to Nursing program, they are disqualified and will not be able to enroll in the nursing program and must reapply at a later date.

If an applicant selected by lottery has taken the ATI TEAS at a prior college, they may submit their TEAS results to the Nursing Department. The same 67% passing score criteria will apply.

If an applicant selected by lottery has taken the TEAS produced by the National League for Nurses or HESI, they may submit their results to the Nursing Department for evaluation for equivalency to the ATI TEAS passing score.
