- Equivalent high school courses taken at other schools, or comparable college credit classes, may satisfy coursework requirements.
- All transferred coursework must have been passed with a grade of C or better.
- The 5 elective credits may be fulfilled by passing a Transitional Studies Level II course, by successful completion of a noncredit vocational course or by transferring three CCSF college credits. All coursework must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
