Current federal law requires that all **male** recipients of federal financial aid **MUST** comply with Selective Services registration provisions. Because Selective Service has not been able to confirm your registration or your exemption status, you must complete one of the following steps:

1. Submit in person a photocopy of your Selective Service registration card to this office. If you have previously registered, but do not have documentation of your registration, contact the *Selective Service Agency* by calling **(1) 847-688-6888** to obtain documentation or your registration number.
- OR**
2. If you are under 26 and have not previously registered, you must register by visiting your local Post Office, or register on-line at web site: www.sss.gov. Once you receive proof of registration from the Selective Service Agency, submit this proof to our office.
- OR**
3. If you are exempt from registration, or if you are 26 years of age or older, and have not previously registered, you must call the *Selective Service Agency* **(1) 847-688-6888** to obtain instructions to resolve the matter.

Gender and Registration: Only individuals who were born male are required to register.

Upon receiving a confirmation of your status from the Selective Service System, please submit it to the Financial Aid Office along with your letter of explanation.

Exemptions	Documentation to Support Exemptions
Males who are not yet 18 at the time FAFSA was completed	Proof of 18 th Birth Date Before FAFSA Was Filed. <i>No update required even if you turn 18 in the academic year. Make sure to register before applying for the next academic year.</i>
Born before 1960	Proof of Birth Date Before 1960
Noncitizens who arrived in U.S. after age 26	<i>Proof of arrival in U.S.: I-94 Form; Green Card; Foreign Passport with Stamp of Entry (Note: Naturalization Certificates or U S Passports are insufficient because they can be issued long after arrival into U.S.)</i>
Noncitizens Who Entered U.S. on Valid <u>Nonimmigrant Visa</u> and Remained On This Visa After Age 26	<i>F1, Visitor's, B1 Visa</i>
Served on Active Duty and Have <u>Anything Other Than Dishonorable Discharge</u>	<i>DD214 Form</i>
Citizens of Republic of Palau, Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia	If lived in US for more than one year, must register.
All Other Exemptions, such as <i>hospitalization, incarceration, institutionalization, Enrolled in Officer Procurement Program, Commissioned Public Health Service Officer, Gender Change</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please see Financial Aid Office Staff. • If you <u>were clearly exempt</u> for the entire time from age 18 to 26, provide written statement and official documentation (for example: document from the correction facility may serve as a proof of incarceration) . • If you <u>were not exempt for the entire time</u>, You must call the Selective Service Agency at 1-847-688-6888 to obtain Status Information Letter. When the letter is received, please see the Financial Aid Office Staff.
