Frederick Harris is a virtuoso pianist equally at home in the realms of Beethoven and Bebop. This new, 6-movement work for solo piano, composed by City College Music Instructor Lenny Carlson, is almost entirely notated, but is set in different jazz styles: modern blues, jazz waltz, latin, classic blues, avant garde and ragtime. The lecture-demonstration will feature insight into the communication between composer and performer and the rigorous preparation to bring a work of this complexity to the concert stage.

The evening concert will feature the premiere performance of *EARTH TONES*, along with other selected classical and jazz/standard repertoire pieces.
