

**FOUR FIRES HAVE BEEN SET ON PHELAN/OCEAN CAMPUS**

**CCSF offers \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of arsonist**

Room 348 of Cloud Hall was severely damaged by fire on the evening of Tuesday, February 5, 2002, the latest in a series of four blazes set by an arsonist or arsonists who remain at large. City College of San Francisco is offering a \$5,000 reward for information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible.

Two of the arson-set fires were severe enough to require the services of the San Francisco Fire Department to put out. The damage from those blazes was such that the classrooms can not be used until they are repaired by our CCSF craftspersons.

The other two fires were caught early enough so that CCSF Public Safety Officers were able to extinguish the blazes before any damage occurred.

All of the fires were set between the late afternoon and early evening hours when activity on the Phelan/Ocean campus is less than during the day or evening.
