

Time changed to 10:30 A.M. March 17 for state-wide rally in Sacramento

Thirty-two buses will leave at 8:30 A.M. on Monday, March 17 from Ocean Avenue, Southeast, John Adams, Downtown, Mission, Chinatown/North Beach and Alemany campuses and 33 Gough St for the journey to Raley Field in West Sacramento to protest the Governor's proposed state budget cuts to California community colleges.

The one-mile-long march will begin at 10:30 A.M. at Raley Field, cross the Tower Bridge and move along Capital Mall to the West Steps of the Capitol.

The rally will end approximately 2 P.M. and everyone will head back to Raley Field to board the buses for the trip back to San Francisco.
