The meeting will be held Wednesday, December 6 at Gordon J. Lau Elementary School, 950 Clay Street. It will begin at 6 P.M.

The deadline to receive information relating to the EIR scope for the Chinatown/North Beach Campus will be December 15. The community will then have 60 days to review the published DRAFT EIR document and comment on its contents.
