### **City College of San Francisco graduation is May 23 in Davies Hall**

SAN FRANCISCO, California, May 12, 2003 — Graduation exercises for the Class of 2003 at City College of San Francisco will be held Friday, May 23 at Davies Symphony Hall in San Francisco Civic Center. The ceremony will begin at 5:30 P.M. Nearly 500 students and 100 faculty members are expected to participate. Admission is by ticket only.

Frances Lee, who has served as Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs for 12 years at City College of San Francisco, will be the keynote speaker. She is retiring after a 30-year career at CCSE, where she was the first Dean of the Chinatown/North Beach Campus. Lee, a graduate of City College of San Francisco, holds a Master of Social Work from Fresno State University.

The student speaker will be Joanne Chew, a San Francisco native who had plans to major in veterinary medicine, but changed her major to theatre arts after working for local film projects and plays. She plans to further her education at San Francisco State University and at Studio A.C.T.
