Approval to submit an application and accept funds received - CA Community Colleges Chancellor's office (Resolution No. 000622-B15)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Authorization to submit an application and appropriate all funds related to a grant from the Chancellor's Office, California Community Colleges for the Pan American Unity: Using a Mural for Education. In this program faculty will integrate the college's Pan American Unity mural into their courses. A resource book and other materials will be created and made available to faculty. City College of San Francisco will also work with non-CCSF community college faculty and high school faculty to incorporate the mural into their classes. The funds will be used to develop materials and resources as well as create a web-site for distribution of materials. The CCSF departments of Latin American Studies, Art, Music and Social Sciences will be involved with the project. The total of the grant is \$19,997 for the period of July 1, 2000 to June 30, 2001.

A \$7,500 in-kind match of faculty salary is required. No additional space required. City College of San Francisco is the fiscal agent. The Mexican Museum of San Francisco is our partner in the project.
