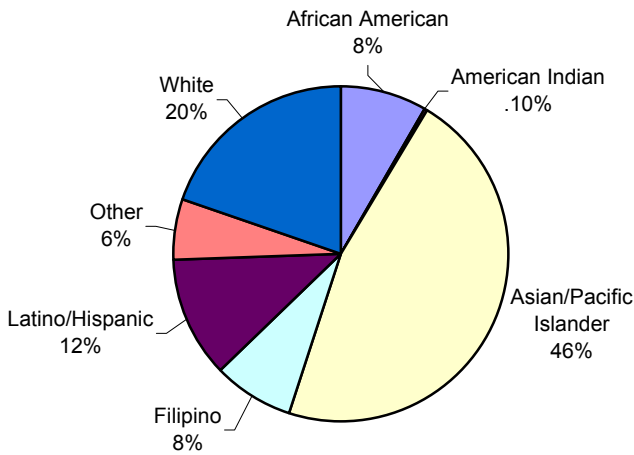


**Associate Degrees by Ethnicity**

*Asian students receive 47% of all degrees awarded, significantly higher than the Asian student representation in the overall Credit enrollment (35%). Latino students and white students have lower graduation percentages (Latino 12% vs. 15%, white 20% vs. 28%).*
