



CITY COLLEGE TRANSFERS • FALL 1996-1997

The Office of Research, Planning and Grants recently received statistics on students who transferred to another institution in the Fall semester of 1997. The California Postsecondary Education Commission (CPEC) provides this information which includes the most recent data available on students who have transferred from City College.

The figures include students who left City College to attend school at the University of California, California State University, or other California Community Colleges. The numbers do not include students who transferred to private institutions within the State of California or any institutions outside the State. Fall figures also do not include transfers during other semesters. An additional 20-30 percent (30-40 students) transfer to UC and an additional 50-60 percent (400-500 students) transfer to CSU during the spring and summer terms.

Included is a table which shows the transfers for Fall 1996 and Fall 1997 to CSU and UC. During the Fall 1997 semester, 613 City College students transferred to CSU and another 219 transferred to UC. This compares to 744 CSU transfers and 190 UC transfers during the previous fall. An additional 782 students transferred to other California Community Colleges compared to

784 in Fall 1996. The largest numbers of students transferred to San Francisco State University (469 students), UC Berkeley (125 students), San Jose State University (61 students), UC Davis (45 students), and CSU Hayward (33 students).

Fall '97 transfers include 34 African Americans, 6 American Indians, 392 Asians and Pacific Islanders, 34 Filipinos, 73 Latinos, 172 Whites, and 121 non-respondents. The only significant differences from 1996 transfers are for African American students whose number of transfers decreased from 76 in 1996 to 34 in 1997.

The number of women transferring to UC has also been increasing. In Fall 1996, 90 women transferred from CCSF to UC. In 1997, that number increased to 109 transfers. This represents an increase from 47% to 50% of all City College transfers to UC. Transfers to CSU in 1997 included 349 women and 264 men.

According to a recent study by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, City College ranks 2nd in the state in transfers to CSU and 10th statewide in transfers to UC.
