

Parking and Transportation Minutes

11/8/05

Old business

- a) The bike racks are being used and we have noticed this around the campus. Muriel L. Parenteau brought up the idea of installing new bike racks around the campus on a yearly basis. Bikes however are still being locked up among handrails around the campus. Carl Koehler will have the student officers tag more often and boot if necessary.
- b) Muriel L. Parenteau and Carl Koehler have yet to check out unusual parking spots in North Science. It is difficult to enforce these "unusual spots." Muriel L. Parenteau, Carl Koehler, Jim Keenan will go out to see the spot before the next meeting. A question was asked if motorcycles are allowed to park up there, and if so, do they have to be handicap? There are motorcycles with handicap parking license plates and they would be allowed. Also faculty/staff motorcycles are allowed to park in North Science.
- c) Muriel L. Parenteau responding to a request from a staff member to establishing a parking spot in a certain place on West Drive. The spot in question is the bulb-out area in front of Facilities and Planning. If a spot is to be added, then it will be marked Compact as to discourage SUV's or other large size vehicles from parking there. Carl Koehler, Jim Keenan, Muriel L. Parenteau will check out location on 11/9/05.
- d) Carl Koehler reported that all the signs are up in the reservoir. Signs include the *10mph*, *No parking*, and *No biking* and they are all being enforced. Carl Koehler will also look into adding that Cross traffic ahead sign for the faculty entry/exit at the top of the reservoir.
- e) The bus stop across from the Bookstore Annex on the college side of Phelan will not be moving now. Carl Koehler has talked to MUNI and told them that we are not going ahead with the moving due to all the complications or dealing with different city agencies just to move the stop 50 feet.
- f) We recommended having a sign for the Bungalow 700 small parking area across from K-Lot. These spots are being used by some students now since there is now signage up in the area. Sign will be posted on the bungalows and will state *Faculty/Staff parking only*.

New Business

- a) Spaces were taken away on Cloud Circle due to construction. Some handicap spaces were taken too and needed to be replaced over by Ram Plaza. Once construction is completed in the area, all spaces will return to its previous configuration.
- b) The idea of City Car Share is still open. The FRC committee has not formed a Task force yet to take on the project of determining possible locations. Muriel L. Parenteau will mention it again at the next FRC meeting. The campus may want to consider both Zip Car and City Car Share.
- c) Carl Koehler would like new wooden sawhorse signs for the college, about 7 or 8, to replace the broken/breaking signs that are around now. The old ones have either been run

over, broken, tagged, etc. Jim Keenan & Carl Koehler will discuss the details about B & G making them.
