

AGS Committees: In order to help advance AGS throughout the semester and encourage participation, every candidate is asked to join a committee. In your committee, you may help with the regular duty to keep AGS going, or you may be asked to complete a special project on your own or work with other members. Joining the committee creates opportunities to practice your leadership skills, show off your talents, and make new friends. What ever you do, your committee work is important and the advance of the chapter will depend on the good quality of your work. All members of the committee report directly to your Committee Chairperson.

News Letter committee: Chaired by the News Letter Editor, the newsletter committee is responsible for the publication of the official newsletter of the chapter, the Omegazette. Omegazette is a bi-weekly publication that contains the latest information about AGS events, meeting schedules, and announcements, etc. Members of the committee meet regularly and report directly to the chair.

Finance Committee: Chaired by the Treasurer, the Finance Committee is responsible for organizing fund raising events. As a tradition, the Finance Committee shall be responsible for ordering See's Candies and BBQ fund raise at Ram Plaza. Note that Treasurer is under no obligation to disclose any financial information of the chapter to the members of the Finance Committee.

Human Resource Committee: Chaired by the membership secretary, the Human Resource Committee is responsible for new member recruitment, maintain a well-organized record of all members, and provide answers to questions regarding membership admission, procedures, deadlines and schedules as well as questions regarding scholarships.

Community Outreach Committee: The Community Outreach Committee is responsible for contacting and cooperating with other community organizations both on campus and in the neighborhood. The mission of the Committee is to 1. maintain relationship with other organizations and introduce their successful experiences to the chapter; 2. seek volunteer opportunities for the members of the chapter; 3. keep track of up coming events in the community and organize participation.

Tutoring Committee: The Tutoring committee is responsible for the organization of the AGS tutoring session and recruitment of tutors.

Web Committee: The web committee is responsible for the design and maintenance of the official website of the committee. The mission of the committee is to assure that the website remains a useful tool of communication and advertisement for the chapter. Committee members must work closely with other committees and the officers of the chapter to make sure that the website is updated regularly.
