for Student-Created Works

Copyright ownership of works created by students that are specifically ordered (as part of GRPH 68 Design and Prepress Production Class Assignments) by the Graphics Communications Department of City College of San Francisco on behalf of actual clients with whom the department is contracted belong to the department and the college.

As Owner of the copyright, the department and college have the exclusive rights to:

- reproduce the copyrighted work,
- prepare derivative work based upon the work,
- distribute copies of the work to the public, and
- display the work to the public.

An exception to reproducing or displaying the work exists when the student-creator of the work includes a reproduction of the work as part of an overall portfolio presentation for self-promotion but not for commercial purpose. Copyright ownership still belongs to the department and college.
