Examples: plan a community service project

Where would you like to go outside of class to learn more about your community, San Francisco, etc.?

Example: Angel Island

Guest Speakers

What kind of guest speakers would you like to invite to class to talk about issues you think are important?

Example: someone to talk about immigration laws
