

CHEMISTRY PLACEMENT TESTING SPRING 2010

Students who wish to enroll in Chemistry 101A or 103A are required to meet

1.) **one** of the following **Chemistry** prerequisites:

- Completion of CHEM 40 or 50 at CCSF with a C or better.
or
- Score of 3 or better on the Advanced Placement Exam in chemistry;
or
- Placement into CHEM 101A or 103A through the Chemistry Diagnostic Placement Exam
and

2.) **one** of the following **Math** prerequisites:

- Completion of MATH 860 (or proof of MATH 860 skills)
or
- Placement into any course higher than MATH 860
