

Student Agreement for Service-Learning Participation

Welcome to Service-Learning: We're pleased you will be joining us in our service-learning program, which combines experiential learning with community service. This semester, you will be participating in a service-learning project designed by your faculty sponsor. The purpose of "service-learning" is to enhance classroom instruction by providing students with relevant practical field experience, and at the same time to meet the needs of our community partners. The specific goals and learning outcomes of your project have been developed by your course instructor/faculty sponsor.

Your faculty sponsor will give you a Course Syllabus and additional information that describe the kind of service that you will engage in and identify the community partner or service site, and state the requirements and the learning outcomes of your service experience and the academic credit that you will receive for your service. If you have not already received this information, please ask your faculty sponsor for it.

As a participant in the City College of San Francisco Service-Learning Program, we ask that you read and sign the following Student Agreement.

Service-Learning Student Agreement

1. I have met with my course instructor/faculty sponsor and understand the requirements and goals of the service-learning project that I will participate in and the academic credit that I will receive for my service.
2. In addition to the course requirements of my service-learning project, I agree to complete the necessary forms, evaluations and other paperwork required by either the Office of Mentoring and Service-Learning or the site supervisor.
3. I agree to comply with the site organization's policies, standards and regulations and serve in a professional manner.
4. I have read the attached Student Guidelines and Limitations for Service-Learning Participation and agree to adhere to them.
5. I understand that if I fail to meet the instructor/course requirements or to follow the service site's policies that I may be asked to terminate my service.
6. If I am going to provide service to an organization that works with children and/or youth (a K-12 site, after-school program, youth organization, etc.), I agree to read and sign the Office of Mentoring and Service-Learning Program Contract for Youth Service or the Child Development Field Experience Contract, if applicable.
