



CCSF Networks Use Policy

1. Each user must be a currently registered student of City College of San Francisco (CCSF) with a valid Student ID card.
2. Each user must have a current, signed **CCSF Computer User Agreement** on file.
3. All hardware and accessories must be provided by the user. CCSF Networks does NOT provide computers, wireless cards, network cables and the like.
4. The only technical support provided for students is via the website (www.ccsf.edu/wifi) or by e-mail (wlan@ccsf.edu).
5. The CCSF network is provided for the convenience of students doing school related research and work.
6. No printing is available on the CCSF network. You may use the express print stations available in the LAC (2nd Floor of the Rosenberg Building) or the Word Processing Room (5th Floor of the Library). Other printers are available in various computer labs (www.ccsf.edu/Resources/comlabs.html).
7. Users of the CCSF Networks are not authorized to create additional services: to include, but not limited to servers, gateways, hosts, printing, gaming, file sharing, VOIP, or the streaming of audio or video.
8. CCSF Network users do not have priority over other patrons for seating purposes.
9. Computer related sounds must not be overheard. Uses of headphones are authorized as long as you can still hear Public Address announcements.
10. Remember that you are privately computing in a public place. Disruptions will not be tolerated.
