

ATTENTION PELL GRANT RECIPIENTS!

As a Writing Success Project (TRIO) student, you may be eligible for additional grant funds from the U.S. Department of Education. This year, the WSP will offer about 20 awards of \$400 to a group of active WSP participants.

Current WSP students are encouraged to apply for funds if they:

- 1) receive a Pell Grant in 2009-2010 .
- 2) enroll in a designated Spring 2010 WSP section and plan to attend weekly study group sessions. Some exceptions may be made for students who enroll in a Spring 2010 WSP-LERN class.
- 3) are enrolled in a minimum of 12 units at CCSF in Fall 2009 or Spring 2010.

WSP participation is a factor in awarding these grants. We have records of attendance at WSP study groups, appointments with WSP Counselor Josephine Loo and WSP Instructor Erin O'Briant, the WSP field trip to UC Berkeley, WSP Success Seminars, and WSP-LERN classes.

Applicants will be ranked according to the above priorities. Then, applicants with the greatest *unmet need, according to their financial aid award*, will be given priority.
