I am pleased to announce the appointment of Tom Boegel as acting Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs, effective immediately. I will bring the appointment of Tom to the Board of Trustees on October 26 for its review and formal approval.

Tom will serve through the start of the spring 2018 semester, when Anna Davies is scheduled to return from FMLA leave.

In appointing Tom, I concur fully with the recommendation of the selection committee.
