

## **Federal Pell Grant Update – Summer 2018**

Starting Summer 2018, Pell Grant Awards maybe available all year round, even if you have exhausted your award for the 2017-2018 academic year. Some, not all students may qualify for the year round Pell Grant. Eligibility requirement:

- Enroll at least half-time (6+ credits)
- Have 2017-2018 Pell Grant eligibility
- Have a 2018-2019 FAFSA on file with CCSF

## **Pell Grants for Summer 2018**

Beginning Summer 2018, Pell Grant eligible students can receive up to 150% of their scheduled Pell award each year. *What does this mean for you?* If you were a Pell eligible student in Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 and used all or most of your 2017-2018 award, you may qualify for a Pell Grant for the Summer 2018.

## **Eligibility for year round Pell Grant**

To be eligible for a summer Pell Grant, you must:

- Have completed a 2017-2018 FAFSA and 2018-2019 FAFSA
- Be Pell Grant eligible
- Enroll in summer classes
- Enroll in at least half-time (6+ credits)
- Be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Have lifetime Pell Grant eligibility remaining

**Note:** Students who have not used all of their scheduled award for the 2017-2018 may be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant during the Summer semester, even if they are in *less than half-time enrollment (0.5 – 5.5 units)*. Verify eligibility with the Financial Aid office.

## **Check your Lifetime Eligibility**

You can check for your remaining Pell Grant eligibility level online by logging on to [nslds.ed.gov](https://nslds.ed.gov), using your FSA ID. View your Lifetime Eligibility Units (LEU) on the Financial Aid Review page.

**Note:** If you are eligible for the year round Pell Grant, you may be simultaneously awarded for the 2018-2019 academic year, be aware this is a tentative award. The Financial Aid office will begin sending 2018-2019 award letters in late July, to students who have no outstanding requirements.
