



Dashkevich and Hall Receive All-State Honors

CCSF Women's BBall Also Well Represented on All-Conference Teams

The 2013 – 2014 CCCAA Northern California All-State Teams featured two sophomores from the Women's North Coast Conference Champion CCSF Rams. Guard Tatsiana Dashkevich and Guard Franeka Hall were named to the all-state first team and second-team, respectively.

Dashkevich and Hall were solid contributors for the Rams throughout the year. Dashkevich's per-game averages include 13.1 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. Hall also filled up the stat sheets during the season, averaging 13.3 points, 10.8 rebounds, and 2.7 assists per game.

"I'm very proud of our team and what we accomplished this year. Winning a conference championship is always a goal set at the beginning of the year and we achieved it with a perfect 12-0 record," Head Coach Jamie Hayes said. "We had a great group of young ladies who were committed, competitive, and just enjoyed being together. I really enjoyed my time with this group."

The Rams were also well represented in the North Coast All-Conference Teams. Dashkevich, Hall, sophomore guard Raquel Torres, and sophomore forward Geena Greene received all-conference first team selections. Sophomore forward Kiah Knox received a second team selection, and freshman Mariah Masoli earned an honorable mention nod.

Led by this decorated group, the Rams captured the conference championship with a perfect 12-0 record (25-4 overall). The Rams received the fifth seed going into the CCCAA NorCal Regionals; however, their successful season ended in the third round versus Sierra.
