Knox, Hall, and Greene signing National Letters of Intent

Three members of the women's basketball North Coast Conference Champion CCSF Rams signed their National Letters of Intent yesterday to play for California State University, Los Angeles. Sophomores Franeka Hall, Geena Greene, and Kiah Knox will be donning the black and gold of the Cal State L.A. Golden Eagles next fall.

The NCAA Division II Golden Eagles will be receiving a trio that led the Rams to an outstanding 25-4 record, which included a 12-0 perfect conference record en route to the championship.

The all-state first team selection Hall averaged 13.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per game during the season. Greene, an all-conference first team member, averaged 7.4 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. All-conference second team Knox also filled the stat sheet with an average of 10 points and 6.4 rebounds per game.

Head Coach Jamie Hayes, who will have the task of finding replacements for these three players, was delighted about the signings.

"They had a great run at CCSF. We are very proud of their achievements and contributions they have made to the program and the opportunities they have made for themselves," Hayes said. "We are excited to see them move on and have the opportunity to continue playing together."
