CCSF Women's Basketball teammates Jessica Alvarez and Samantha Campos signed their letters of intent this past week at City College of San Francisco. Alvarez will play for the Texas A&M International University Dust Devils and Campos will suit up for the Hawaii Pacific University Sharks.

Head Coach Derek Lau said he was proud that both Alvarez and Campos will continue their basketball and educational careers at four-year universities.

"They worked extremely hard all year on and off the court. Both Sam and Jessica deserve everything they have earned," Lau said.

Alvarez performed across the board during her sophomore year for the Rams. In 29 Games played, she averaged 9.8 points, 5.1 rebounds, 1.1 steals, and led the team with a 79.2 free-throw percentage. Her solid all-around play led to a Coast-North Second Team All-Conference Selection.

Campos, who was a redshirt last year, caught the eyes of Hawaii Pacific coaches with her hard work, talent, and dedication, which culminated in her receiving a scholarship from the Sharks.

Alvarez and Campos will be attending their new schools this coming fall semester.
