Eligibility

The criteria for the Koret Scholarships include students who:

- Are existing CCSF students.
- Declare intent to transfer.
- Will enroll for at least one more semester at CCSF beyond the current semester before transferring (for Spring 2018 applications, you must plan to enroll in 12 units at CCSF for Fall 2018).
- Possess a 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Are initially enrolled or are currently enrolled in a Math or English course no more than two levels below transfer level at the time of application submission.
- Are registered at the time of application for 12 or more units with at least one degree-applicable class (depending on their declared major) and at least one Math or English class.

Applications will be processed in the order received and prioritized based on financial need, with priority also given to Veterans, Guardian Scholars, first-generation college students, and students majoring in Business or Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM) disciplines, and students who have not previously received a Koret Scholarship Award.
