## **REQUIREMENTS:**

### **A. GENERAL EDUCATION**

Completion of **ALL transfer General Education requirements** by the end of the semester in which you file your graduation petition. You can use any **one** of the following:

- CSU General Education
- IGETC for CSU
- IGETC for UC (only applicable for students who do not plan to attend a CSU)

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. This degree **also** requires you to meet minimum eligibility to transfer to a CSU (*by the end of the semester in which you file your graduation petition*):
  - a. 60 CSU transferable units
  - b. 2.0 minimum transfer GPA
2. Strongly recommended: completion of the American Institutions and US History requirement.
  - a. Refer to the CSU GE or IGETC handout for appropriate courses.
3. For students transferring to a CSU, completion of this degree will make you a more competitive applicant.
4. Students transferring to a CSU with this degree may get a “bump-up” of their gpa of 0.1 – 0.2 points.
5. For students transferring to a UC, this degree will give you a comprehensive review of your application.
