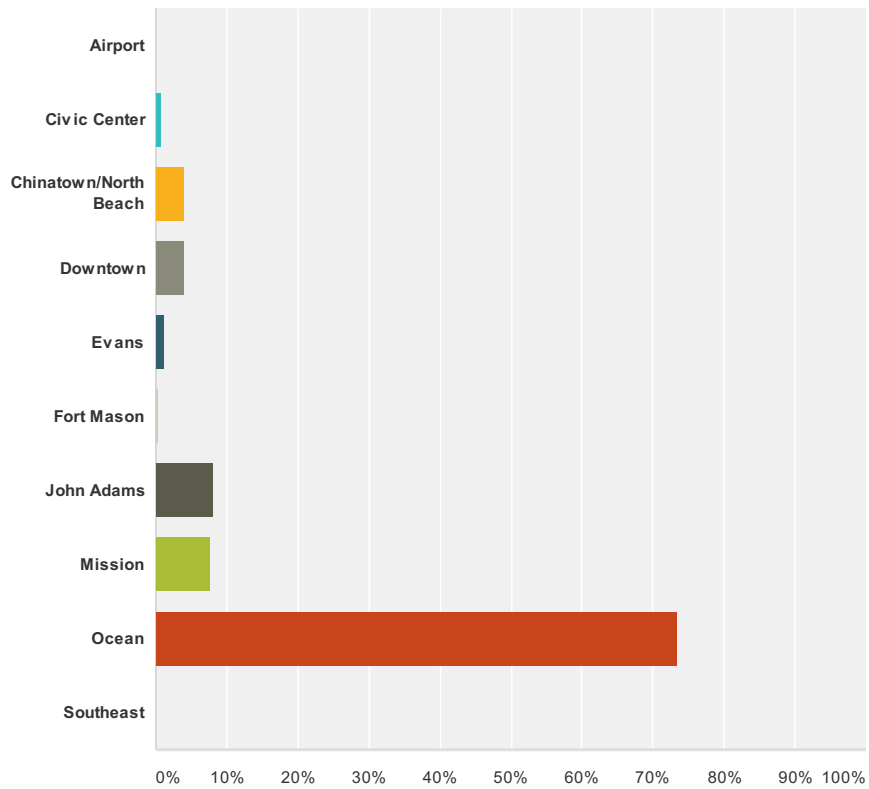


Q1 At which center/campus do you primarily teach?

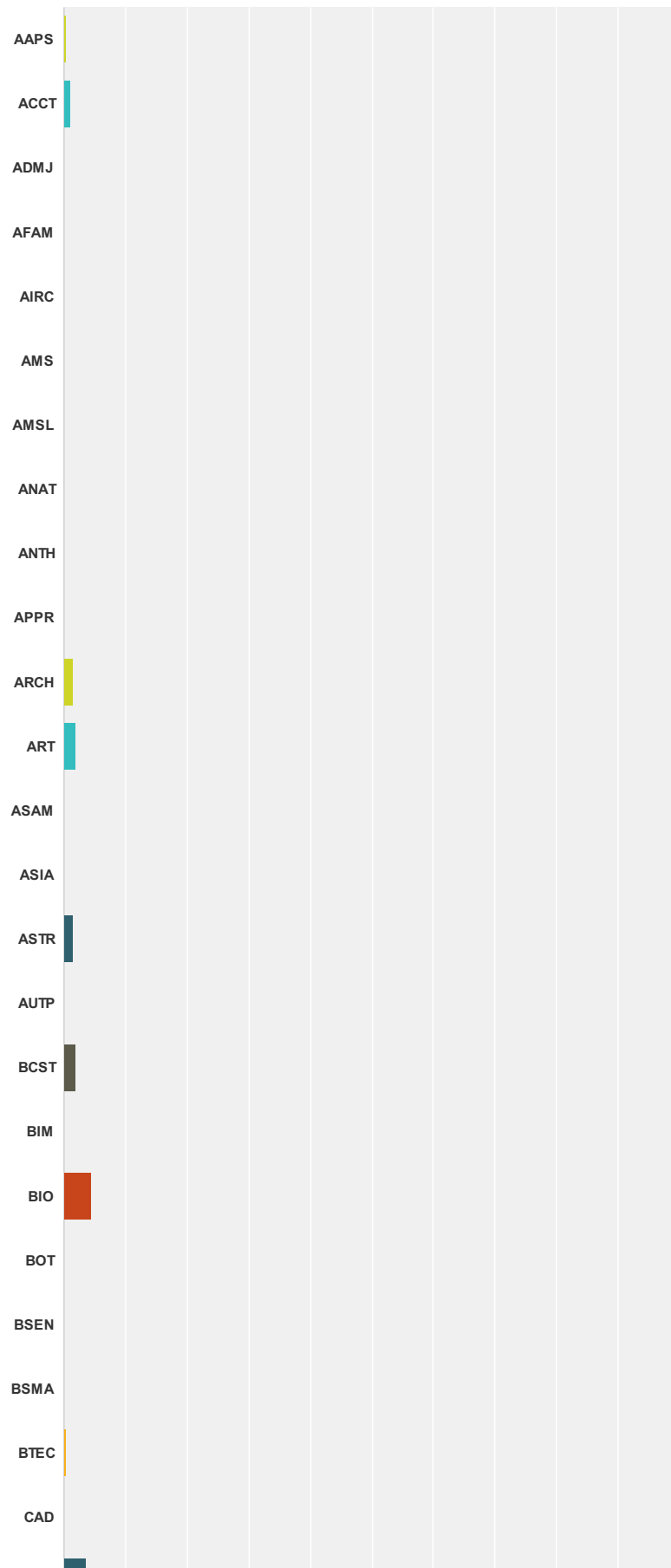

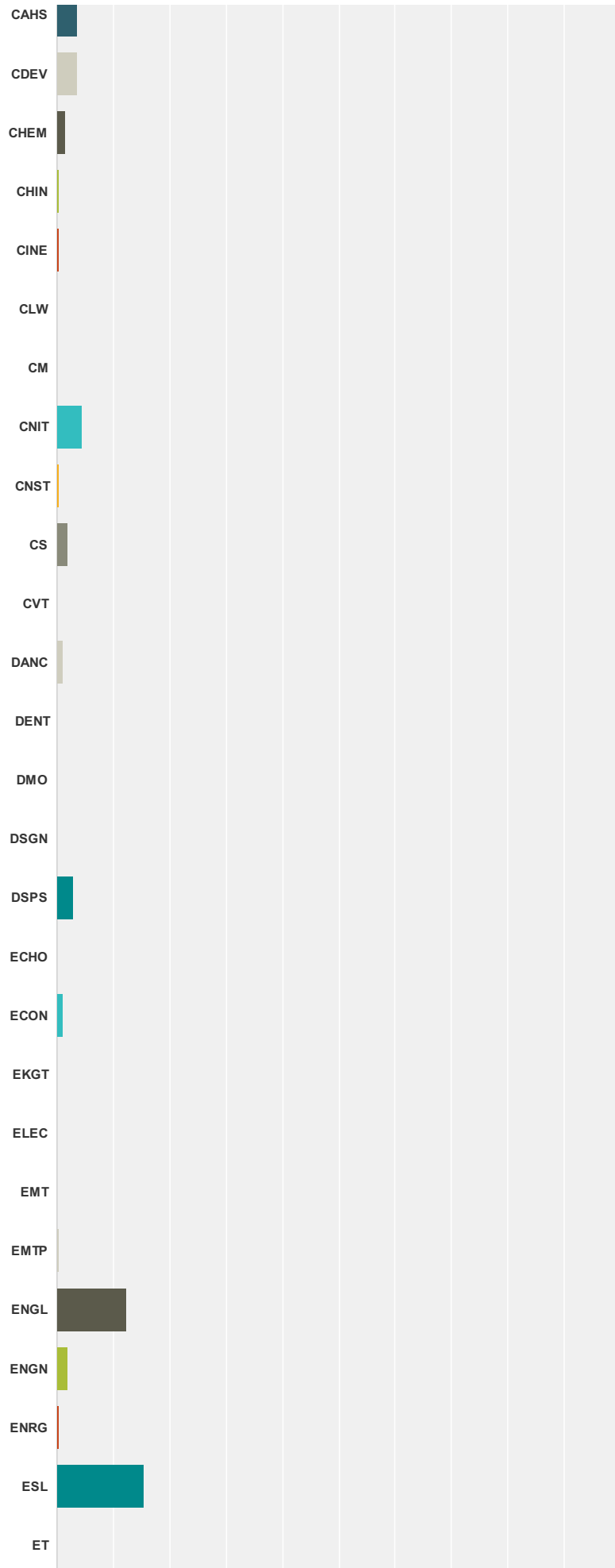

Q2 What is your primary department/program?

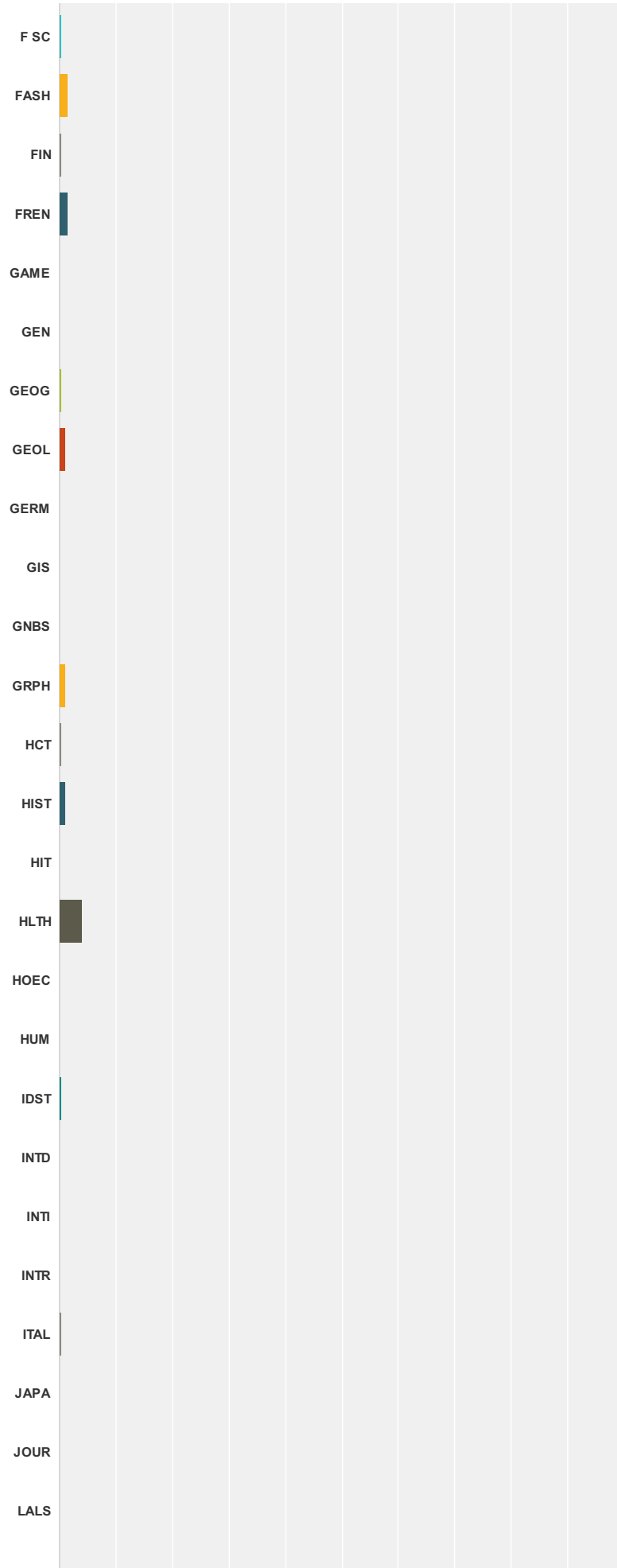

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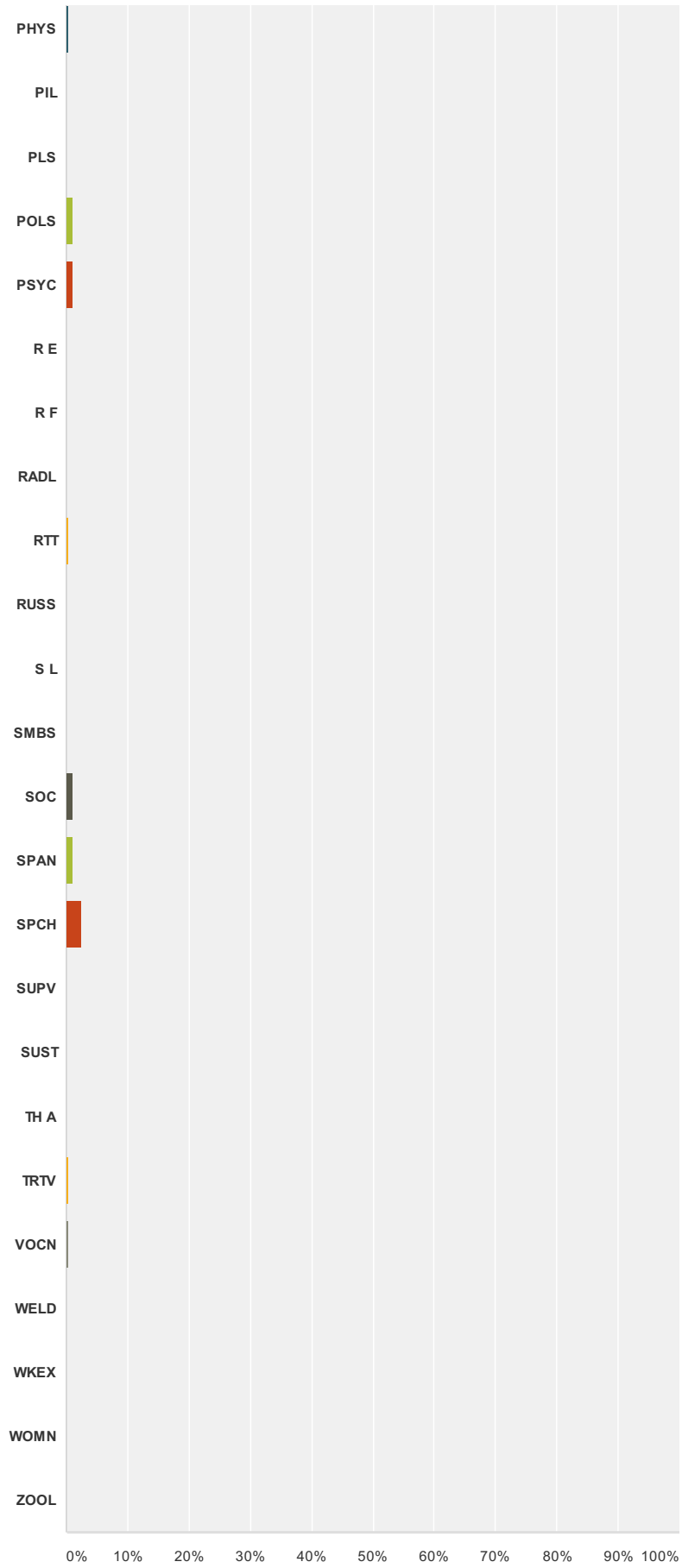

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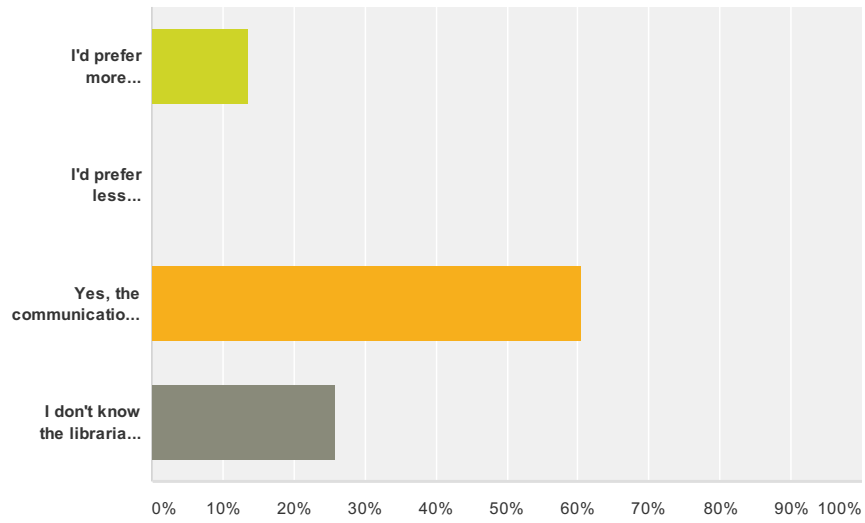

Q3 Are you satisfied with the communication between you and the librarian assigned to your department?

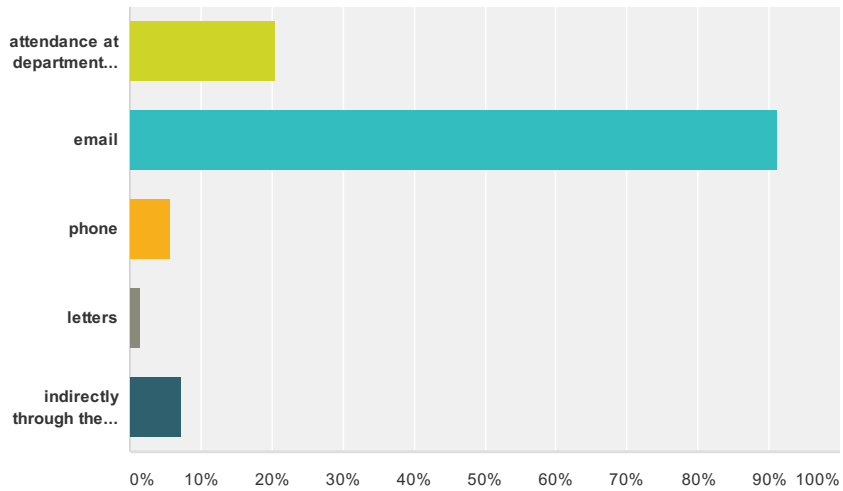

Q4 How do you prefer to be contacted by the librarian assigned as liaison to your department?

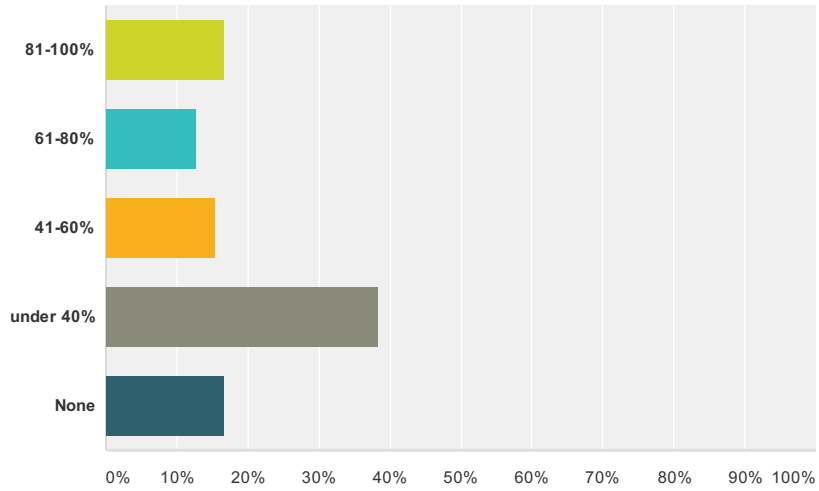

Q5 What percentage of your courses/assignments requires some type of Library/Media Center resources or services?

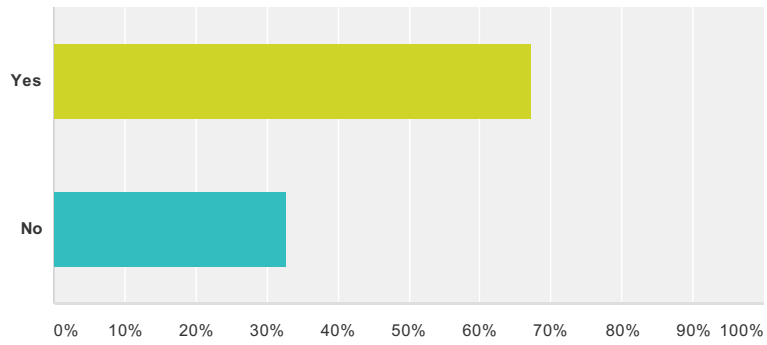

Q6 Do you have assignments that require research or materials beyond the textbook or materials you provide for students?

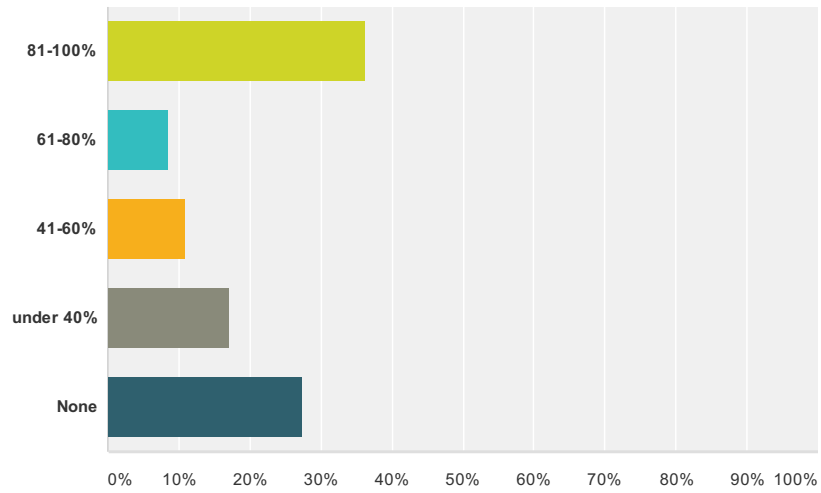

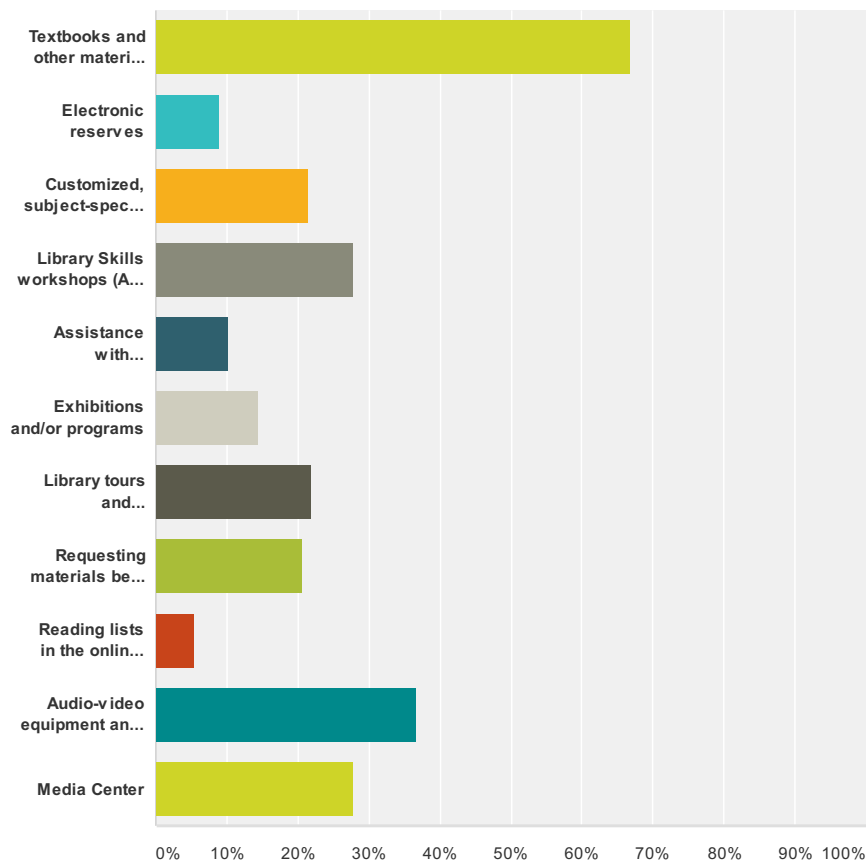

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Q8 I use the following services provided by the library. Check all that apply.

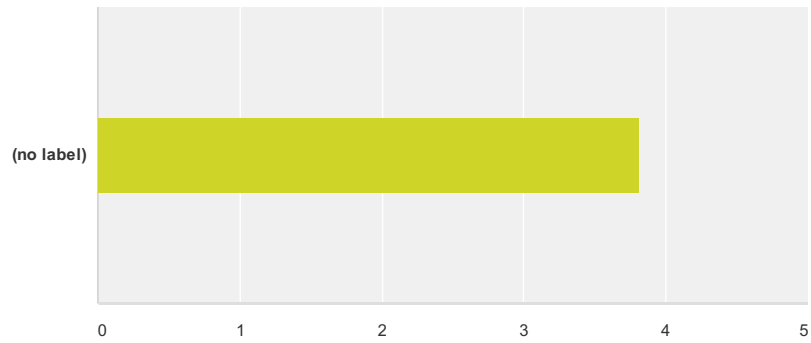

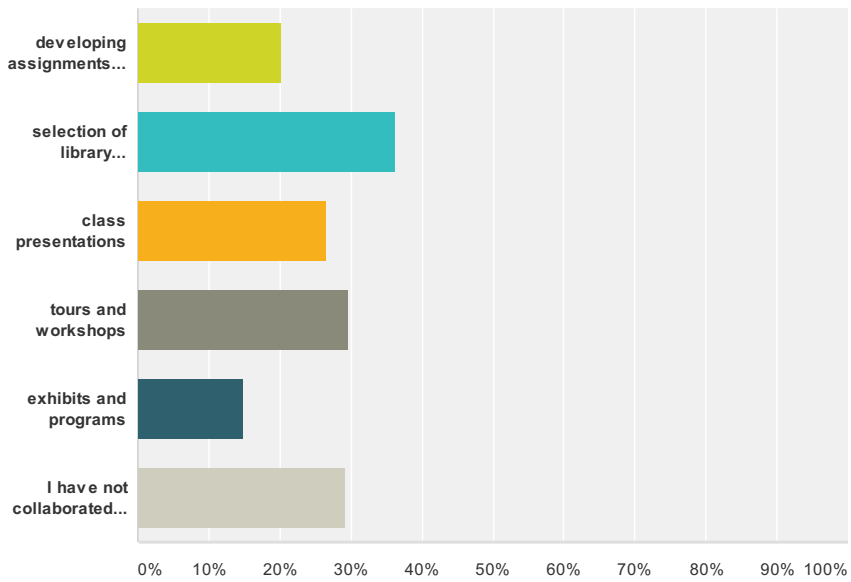

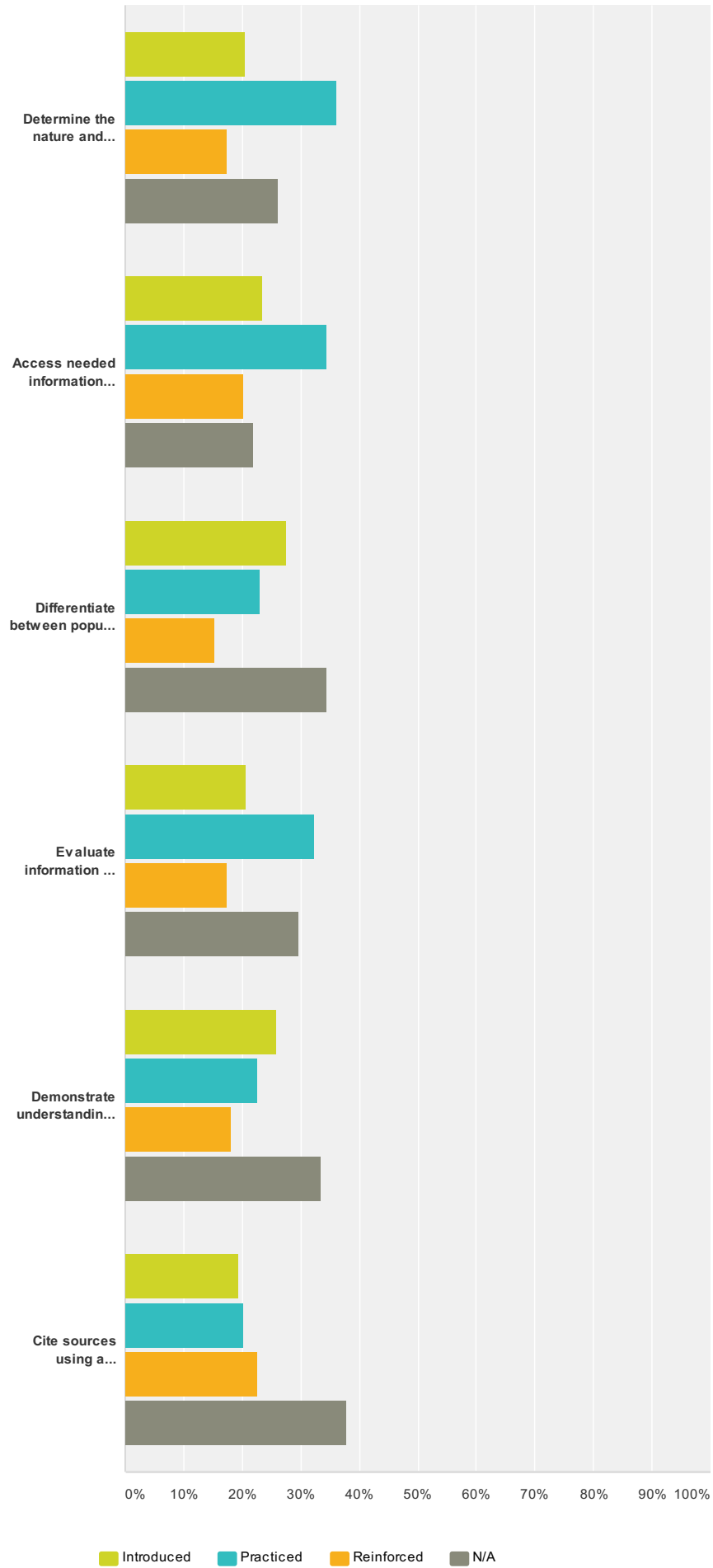

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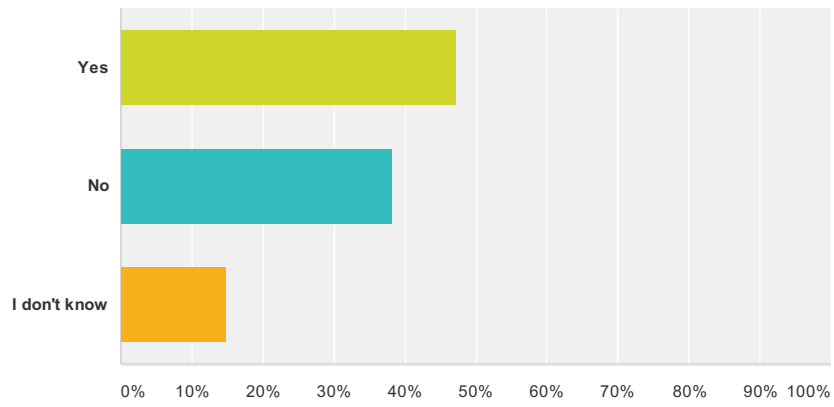

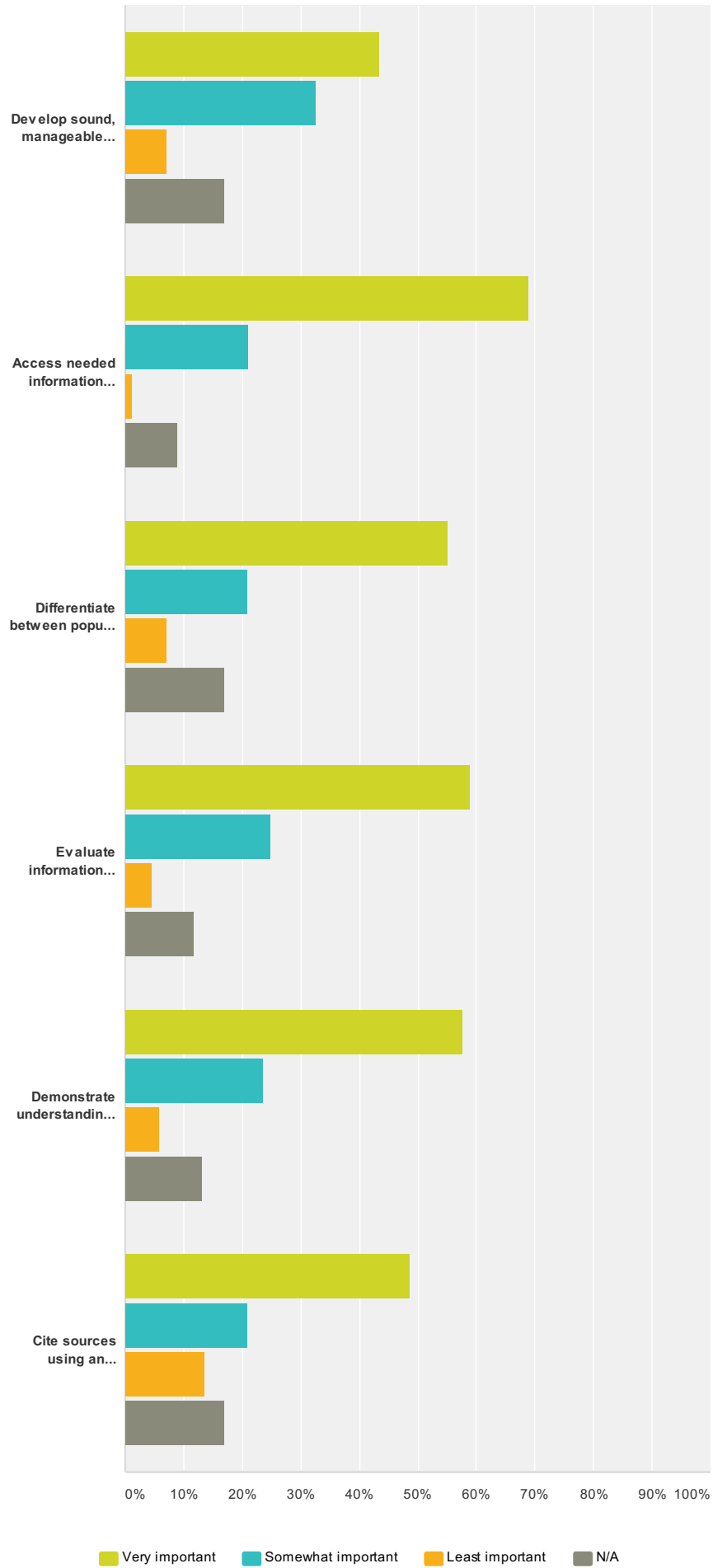
