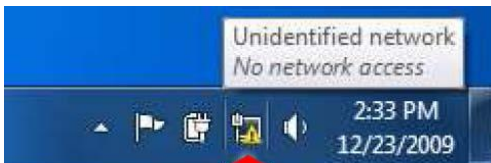



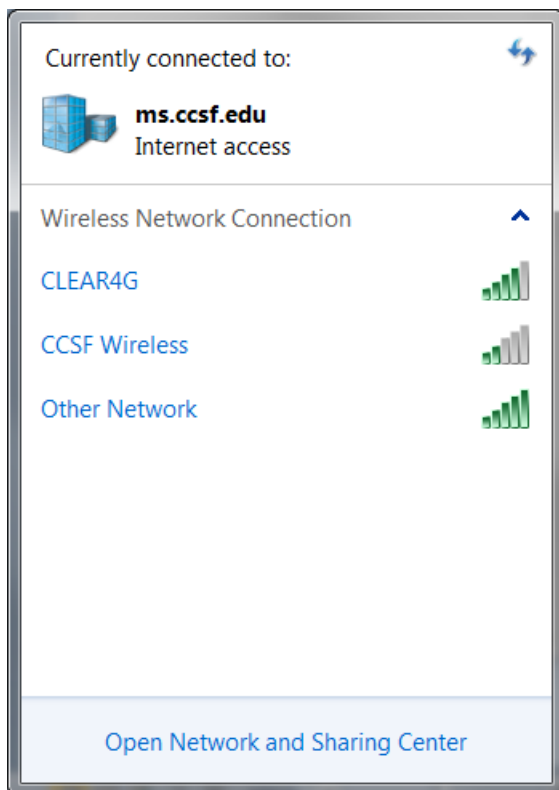
How to Connect Win 7 to the CCSF Wireless Network

1. These directions are for Win 7. Other versions may differ slightly.
2. This assumes that your computer is located where you can get a signal from the CCSF Wireless Network and your wireless card is connected and operational.
3. Bringing your computer in range should produce this information balloon or similar at the bottom right hand corner when you place the cursor on top of the network icon.



 Click on this network icon

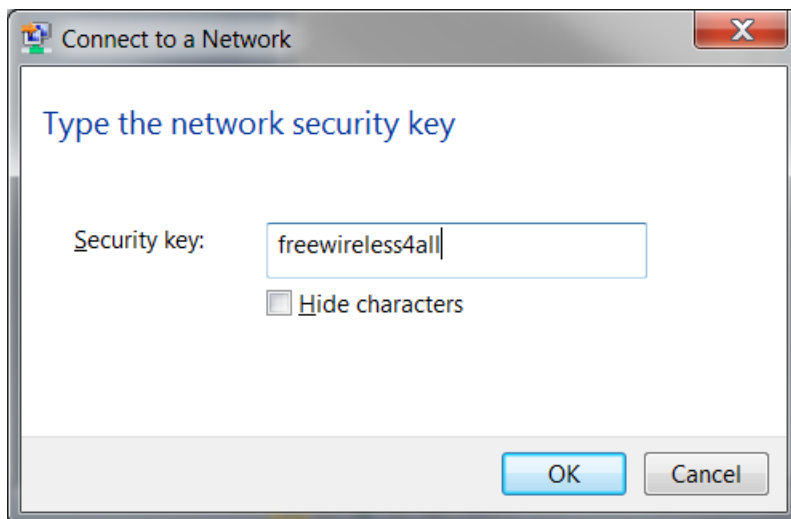
4. This will bring up the Wireless Network Connection window. Click on **CCSF Wireless** to select it.



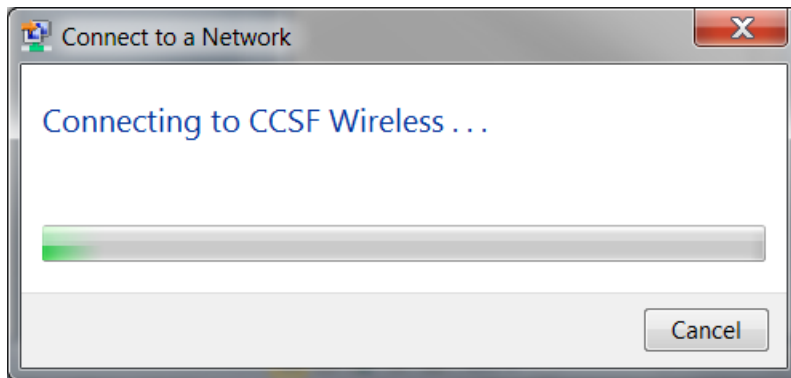
5. Click on the **Connect** button.



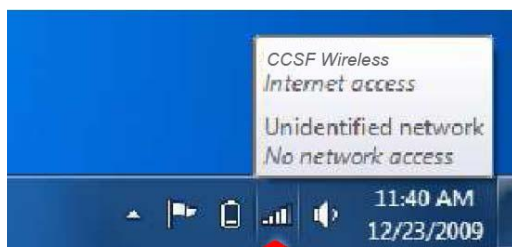
6. You will be prompted to enter a security key. Type in the WPA key (**freewireless4all**) and click the **OK** button.




7. You will get this window while your computer is trying to connect to the CCSF Wireless Network. This may take a few moments.



8. You should see this information balloon after your computer has connected to the CCSF Wireless network. The icon should display some bars depending on the connection strength.
