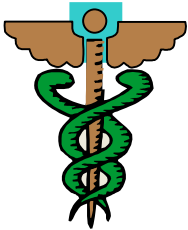

What will this program do for me?

This training program prepares the student for entry-level employment on the nursing career ladder. At the end of this program, students will be ready to take the State Certification Exam for Nursing Assistant and with the basic skills they have learned, students will be prepared to care for patients in convalescent homes, skilled nursing facilities and acute care hospitals.

Can I receive college credit for these classes?

All three classes receive college credit. The classes are particularly suited to further studies in the Nursing and Health Career Programs.

What qualifications do I need to enter the Nurse Assistant Program?

- 1) Students must be 18 years or older.
- 2) Must place into ENGL 90 or **English 86** or ESL 150 or successfully complete English L or ESL 140.
- 3) **PREREQ: Certification of Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR); approved by American Heart Association AHA or American Red Cross for *Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider* only. (CCSF offers EMT 12 BLS Provider course, see current *Class Schedule*)**
- 4) A physical exam and current immunizations; **print out proof of immunizations.**
- 5) Fingerprinting (***Live Scan form***) submitted to Department of Health Services.
- 6) Criminal background check/drug test.

COLLEGE ADMISSION PROCEDURES

All **NEW** and **RE-ADMIT** students (those who have been away from CCSF for one academic year or more previous to the coming semester) need to submit an admission application. **5 Easy Steps** to becoming a CCSF Student:

1. Apply for Admission (Office of Admissions and Records - admit@ccsf.edu; 415-239-3285)
2. Complete the Assessment and Placement (Testing Office 415-239-3128)
3. Attend a New Student Orientation; special orientations are required for Nursing and Allied Health programs
4. Meet with a Counselor (Counseling Office at John Adams Center 415-561-1925)
5. Register for Classes

ASSESSMENT AND PLACEMENT

California law AB705 represents a significant change in the way students are placed. Students may be eligible to enroll in transfer-level math or English classes with additional support. Students may receive English and Math course placements using high school performance data.

Students can complete assessment using one of the options below:

- High school data (www.ccsf.edu/AB705)
- College data and/or SAT, ACT, AP scores, etc. (www.ccsf.edu/waiver)
- Prerequisite challenge (www.ccsf.edu/prereqchallenge)

- Please arrive 15 minutes before start time with your City College ID number and a photo ID.
- Each placement test is 90 minutes long. Seating is limited to 30.

Exemptions to the City College Placement Test(s) are as follows:

1. Interested in a class without math and/or English prerequisites.
Check "Exemption from Matriculation" box in credit application.
2. Already have an associate degree or higher from a U.S. accredited school.
3. Completed a college-level math and/or English 1A equivalent course.

To apply for placement testing waiver, bring a copy of your college transcript to Ocean Campus, (50 **Frida Kahlo Way**), Matriculation Office, Conlan Hall Room 204, or John Adams Center, Student Services Office, Room 143 for assistance.

**To receive an earlier registration date –
complete assessment, attend an orientation, and see a counselor to get an education plan!**
