NEW POLICIES FOR EXEMPT STUDENTS

Beginning Summer 2015, students who are exempt will not be able to surpass their WTW weekly hours. Thus, if you wish to keep your exemption status, you may have to reduce your work study hours and/or unit enrollment. Your WTW weekly hours are determined by the age of your child(ren) and the number of parents in your household. Please see the CalWORKs Work Study Advisor to understand how this policy will impact your work hours.
