The District shall continuously assess its long-term needs for additional and/or replacement sites. The acquisition of additional and/or replacement sites shall be preceded by the review of numerous considerations including any requirements related to the California Environmental Quality Act.

The Board retains the sole responsibility for selecting sites for District programs and activities. The Chancellor shall establish such criteria and procedures as are appropriate to fully inform the Board as to the best alternatives available.

The criteria may include, but are not limited to, the following elements: Enrollment projections and growth potential in the District and the capability of existing sites and/or facilities to absorb the growth.

The ability of programs, services, facilities and delivery methods to serve students from underserved areas.

Compatibility with local, regional, and state-wide plans for higher education.

Site location, size, and accessibility.

Alternatives to site acquisition. Cost and funding options.

Seismic concerns and applicable geologic and soil engineering studies. Aircraft flight paths and any easements affecting the location.
