The maximum educational and monetary value shall be obtained in the purchase of supplies, equipment, and services.

The Chancellor or Vice Chancellor of Finance and Administration is authorized to enter into and to sign agreements on behalf of the District for services necessary to conduct the business affairs of the District. The Board authorizes the Chancellor to evaluate and dispose of personal property belonging to the District by sale or auction or otherwise in accordance with state law.

The authority to encumber District funds shall be limited to actions of the Board, except as Board approved procedures shall designate otherwise.

Purchasing procedures shall be in compliance with the existing law and good business practice.

No member of the Board of Trustees nor an employee of the District shall have an interest in any contract for supplies, equipment, and services made by the Board. No employee shall receive any gift or reward or commission for introducing or recommending an article of a service resulting from such consulting work.
