It is now time to begin the process of developing the Fall 2023 schedule of classes. The production of the schedule of classes is one of the largest collaborative efforts undertaken by the College, and I am very appreciative of the collective effort taken by all of you and by the other members of the College community in this work.

In this memo I would like to emphasize a few important notes. Please take a few minutes to read through this memo carefully. Deans should take time in the next few days to discuss the content of this memo with their department chairs. Additional scheduling details and timelines will be shared in a subsequent memo next week.

Initial instructional budgets are attached to this memo.

As with prior years, initial instructional budgets have been established for both Fall 2023 and Spring 2024. Departments offering both credit and noncredit instruction have separate budgets for each mode.

Most departments will see initial instructional budgets that align with what they received for Spring 2023. Based on the conversations that I had with department chairs, there are some departments with augmented Fall 2023/Spring 2024 instructional budgets.

Department chairs wishing to shift budget between these areas (Fall/Spring, Credit/Noncredit, Disciplines) should discuss this with their supervising Dean. Deans supporting such a shift shall bring these to me for approval.

A separate budget has been established for classes offered in conjunction with SFUSD. Dean Meg Hudson will be in touch with departments to discuss the use of that budget and specific instructional requests from SFUSD.

The College will once again leverage funds from AEP and SWP to help fund classes. This augmentation has already been factored into instructional budgets.

Initial Noninstructional Budgets. Initial noninstructional budgets for selected areas are also attached to this memo. Please note that these initial budgets are intended to cover those departments within Academic Affairs where noninstructional assignments have a significant impact on faculty assignments. Additional noninstructional budgets will be developed for other areas of the College as overall College budget development continues.

In-Person and Online Instruction. Departments may schedule both in-person and online classes (hybrid and 100% online) in Fall 2023. Scheduling remote classes is no longer available as all online classes must be in courses that have approved and active Distance Education Addenda and be taught by IOTL-certified instructors. Departments may not schedule classes in Fall 2023 based on the approval of temporary distance education addenda.

Departments scheduling in-person classes are reminded to put room preference information in the comments field in CourseLeaf.

Timeline. Please be mindful of the deadlines in the attached schedule production timeline.

Academic Calendar. Please refer to the attached Fall 2023 academic calendar when making your scheduling choices. In particular, if you are scheduling shorter-term classes, please note the various parts of term (e.g., 1st half, 2nd half, 6-week, etc.).

Appreciation. As I mentioned at the beginning of this memo, I am grateful for the work that each of you is going to be doing as part of the schedule development process.
