## **Accreditation Steering Committee Update**

Accreditation Steering Committee Objectives for 2022-23:

- 1. Monitor the timeline and process for developing the Institutional Self Evaluation Report (ISER) and ensure that there is broad participation, including collecting and incorporating Collegewide feedback and obtaining endorsements.
- 2. Finalize the ISER and submit to ACCJC in December 2022.
- 3. Monitor and support the development of responses to core inquiries during Spring 2023 as needed.
- 4. Prepare and submit annual and fiscal reports to ACCJC.
- 5. Monitor the need to respond to requests from ACCJC related to being on enhanced fiscal monitoring.

**Note:** The Accreditation Steering Committee has drafted new objectives for 2023-24 and will vote on these during the October meeting. This report focuses only on Objective 3 from the list above. All other objectives have been met for 2022-23 (see also May 4, 2023, PGC Update).

**Progress Related to Objective 3 (Monitor Responses to Core Inquiries).** During a special July meeting, the Accreditation Steering Committee reviewed and discussed the draft responses to the <u>core inquiries</u>. After further refinements, the Board of Trustees <u>accepted the responses on August 24, 2023</u>. We are currently finalizing these responses for submission to ACCJC.

**Invitation to Participate in the Upcoming Site Visit:** As noted in prior updates, the following individuals will conduct the focused site visit October 2-4: Dr. Erika Endrijonas, Dr. Mike Munoz, Dr. Norman Lorenz, Dr. Jesse Mills, and Mr. Daniel Troy.
