Whereas the Faculty Travel is a "+1" item requiring mutual agreement between the Academic Senate and the Chancellor,

Resolved that the Academic Senate approves the updated version of the Faculty Travel/PD Guidelines.

Draft Resolution approving the Credit for Prior Learning Faculty Coordinator Job Description

Resolved, that the Academic Senate approve the Faculty Coordinator job description for the Credit for Prior Learning Faculty Coordinator as presented on Sep 20, 2023.

Draft Resolution for Changing the Name of the School of Communication Studies, English, and World Languages, and the School of Fine, Applied, and Communication Arts to the School of Arts, Communication, and Languages

Whereas, the departments in the current Schools of Communication Studies, English, and World Language and Fine, Applied, and Communication Arts were once housed under the same school, the School of Liberal Arts; and

Whereas, these schools more recently have been centered under the same dean; and

Whereas, a semester-long process involving the dean, chairs, faculty, and staff was undertaken to discuss renaming the area with a single unifying name and to determine the name that would best represent all involved; and

Whereas, the departments involved all approved the name chosen, the School of Arts, Communication, and Languages; therefore, let it be

Resolved, that the Academic Senate for City College of San Francisco endorses the change of name from the School(s) of Communication Studies, English, and World Language and Fine, Applied, and Communication Arts to the School of Arts, Communication, and Languages.
