BOARD POLICY MANUAL**

Title: COURSE REPETITION	Number: BP 6.23
Legal Authority: Title 5, California Code of Regulations, Sections 55040, 55041, 55042, 55044, and 58161	

Students may be permitted to repeat courses under certain circumstances, including:

- Alleviating substandard coursework
- Significant lapse of time
- Extenuating circumstances
- Occupational work experience
- Special classes for students with disabilities
- Legally mandated training requirements
- Significant changes in industry or licensure standards

In addition, certain types of courses may be designated as repeatable, consistent with the requirements of Title 5 Section 55041.

The Chancellor shall establish Administrative Procedures that detail the allowable circumstances and reasonable limitations for course repetition. These procedures will be published in the College Catalog.
