Rocha to begin role of permanent chancellor on July 1

SAN FRANCISCO – City College of San Francisco (CCSF) is pleased to announce that the Board of Trustees voted to ratify the contract for lead Chancellor candidate Dr. Mark Rocha, and will assume District leadership on July 1.
