

COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE FAQs - General

March 13, 2020

Given the evolving nature of this public health situation, all information is subject to change. Changes will be communicated to the College community as quickly as possible.

Important Dates

- Q. What is the plan for students, faculty and staff engagement in the coming weeks?
- A: Face-to-face instruction and student services at CCSF locations is suspended starting Thursday, March 12 at 10:00pm.
 - March 13-20
 - Face-to-face classes at CCSF locations are suspended. Online classes will continue uninterrupted.
 - March 21-29
 NEW Spring Break scheduled.
 - March 30
 Most face-to-face classes resume in modified online learning formats.

General Questions

- Q. How does CCSF define Modified Learning?
- A. Modified Learning is defined as a class that is delivered remotely via Canvas, but was originally designed to be a face-to-face class.
- Q. Will student workers, faculty and staff experience any interruption or loss of pay when they work remotely?
- Q. If face-to-face classes are being offered in instructional locations outside of City College, will these classes continue with face-to-face instruction?
- A. Face-to-face instruction will continue as long as the third-party location site remains open and the instructor is willing to continue instruction.

Q. When can I access CCSF buildings?

A. The period from March 13 through March 20 is being used to prepare for the resumption of instruction and student services on March 30th. While face-to-face instruction and student services are suspended at CCSF locations during this time, administrators, faculty, and classified staff will have limited access to campus buildings as a part of this preparation activity.

Friday, March 13, Monday March 16, and Tuesday March 17

Buildings will be open at the Ocean Campus and at the Centers from 8:00am to 5:00pm.

Wednesday, March 18 through Friday, March 20.

All Centers will be closed. Ocean Campus buildings will be open from 8:00am to 5:00pm. The purpose of having building access during this time is to prepare for the delivery of instruction and student services remotely starting on March 30th. All other on-campus activities (e.g., committee meetings) shall either be rescheduled or conducted remotely.

Details of campus building accessibility after March 20 will be published next week. All employees shall coordinate their work activities for this period with their supervisor. Faculty members should inform their Department Chairs.
