8. Approved Diagnostic Assessment Tool, Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Applicants will be evaluated on all criteria (Steps 1-7) above and ranked for selection. The TEAS score is not required with the nursing application. Top ranking students will be asked to submit their original ATI - TEAS Version 6 <i>first attempt</i> score from ATI testing or take the TEAS exam through the CCSF RN Department. Using the following scoring, these students will then be ranked for selection. Top 50 students in point total will be selected.		
1 Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) or ATI TEAS offered through Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI). 2 Only the first passing score will be counted towards ranking. 3. 62% or above is passing. Students who are selected into the program with an overall TEAS score lower than 62% will require remediation.
