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Student Equity Achievement (SEA) Program

Over the course of last year, the categorical fund leads for Student Equity (SE), Basic Skills (BSI), Student Success (SSSP) worked on creating an integrated plan for the State Chancellor's Office. As a result, the state is now integrating the three funds into one now named the Student Equity and Achievement (SEA) Program.

The SEA, established in Education Code (EC) 78222, consolidates the Basic Skills Initiative (BSI), Student Equity (SE) and the Student Success

and Support Program (SSSP) with the intent of supporting Guided Pathways and the system wide goal to eliminate achievement gaps. A district shall comply with the following: maintain an equity plan; provide matriculation services; adopt placement policies (AB 705) and provide all students with an educational plan.

The SEA Program supports California Community Colleges in advancing the system-wide goal to boost achievement for all students, with an emphasis on eliminating achievement gaps for students from traditionally underrepresented groups.
