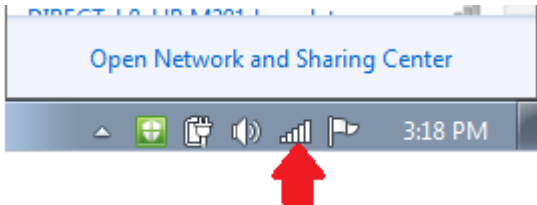


How to Connect Windows 7 to the CCSF Student Network

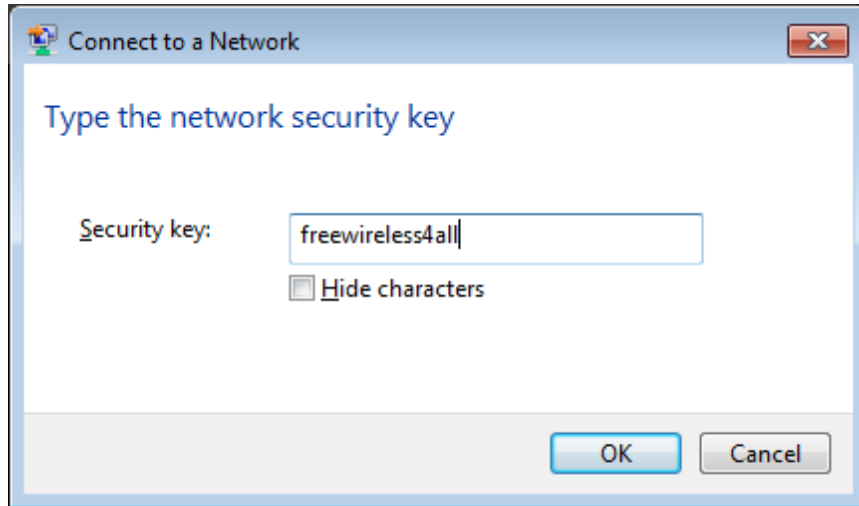
1. These directions are for Windows 7. Other versions may differ slightly.
2. Bringing your computer into WiFi range should produce this information balloon or similar at the bottom right hand corner when you place the cursor on top of the network icon.



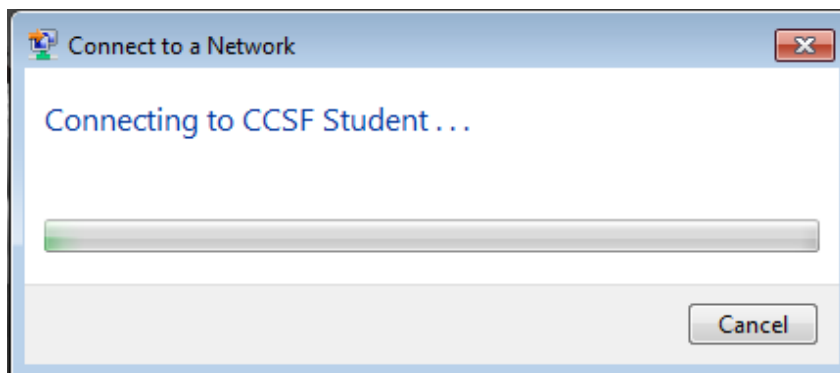
3. This will bring up the Wireless Network Connection window. Select **CCSF Student**, do not select the **Connect automatically** option, then click **Connect**.



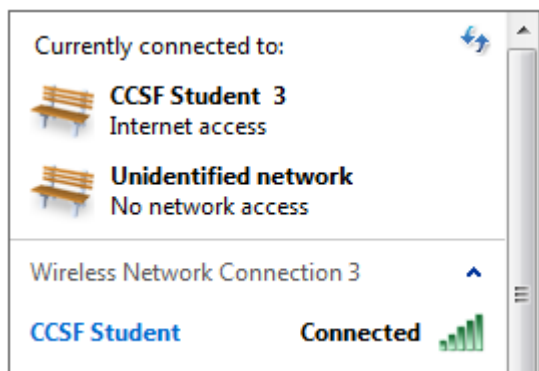
4. You will be prompted to enter a security key. Type in the WPA key (**freewireless4all**) and click the **OK** button.



5. You will get this window while your computer is trying to connect to the CCSF Student Network. This may take a few moments.



6. You should see this information balloon after your computer has **Connected** to the **CCSF Student** network. The icon should display some bars depending on the connection strength.



7. Open your web browser (e.g Safari, Firefox, etc.), and enter any URL (e.g. www.ccsf.edu, www.google.com, etc.). You should see the Welcome CCSF Student login page, where you will enter your **Username** (e.g W00000000 or @00000000) and your **RAM ID Password**. After entering your correct Login Credentials, you might need to open another browser tab and start surfing the net.
